

RESOLUTION NO. 9119

A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Brent Trout, authorizing the City Clerk to issue special event retailers' permits for the Country Stampede event at Heartland Motorsports Park.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

Section 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2704(e) and TMC 9.15.020, cereal malt beverages and beer not exceeding 6% alcohol by volume may be sold for consumption on unpermitted premises that are open to the public at a special event approved by the governing body.

Section 2. Recognizing that the governing body may not be able to meet in sufficient time to approve a resolution authorizing a permit applicant to sell cereal malt beverages and beer not exceeding 6% alcohol by volume for the County Stampede event, the City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue special event retailers' permits to such applicants provided that each applicant complies with the Topeka Municipal Code and state law regulating cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor.

Section 3. Such permits are limited to sales for consumption at the Country Stampede event on June 20 through June 22, 2019 on premises located at Heartland Motorsports Park, 7530 SW Topeka Blvd.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force after its approval by the Governing Body.
