9	Section 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2704(e) and TMC 9.15.020, cereal malt
10	beverages and beer not exceeding 6% alcohol by volume may be sold for consumption on
11	unpermitted premises that are open to the public at a special event approved by the
12	governing body.
13	Section 2. Recognizing that the governing body may not be able to meet in
14	sufficient time to approve a resolution authorizing a permit applicant to sell cereal malt
15	beverages and beer not exceeding 6% alcohol by volume for the County Stampede event,
16	the City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue special event retailers' permits to such
17	applicants provided that each applicant complies with the Topeka Municipal Code and
18	state law regulating cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor.
19	Section 3. Such permits are limited to sales for consumption at the Country
20	Stampede event on June 20 through June 22, 2019 on premises located at Heartland
21	Motorsports Park, 7530 SW Topeka Blvd.
22	Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force after its approval by
23	the Governing Body.
