12	Festival to allow the	e possession and consumption of alcoholic liquor, the governing body hereby	
13	approves the event to	o be held on September 26, 2020, between the hours of 3:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.	
14	provided the sponso	or secures a temporary permit from ABC and complies with all state laws and	
15	ordinances regulatin	g alcoholic liquor.	
16	Section 3.	A portion or all of the following streets/alleys shall be closed to motor vehicle	
17	traffic during the dat	tes and times identified in Section 2: S. Kansas Avenue between SE 6 <sup>th</sup> Avenue	
18	and SE 7 <sup>th</sup> Street; ar	nd SE 7 <sup>th</sup> Street between S. Kansas Avenue and SE Quincy Street. Pursuant to	
19	K.S.A. 41-719 and	41-2645, the sponsor shall ensure that the area in which alcoholic liquor is	
20	possessed or consumed is clearly marked by signs, a posted map or other means ("Designated		
21	Barricaded Area").		
22	Section 4.	Event attendees may purchase, possess and consume alcoholic beverages	
23	within the Designat	ed Barricaded Area. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719, no alcoholic liquor may be	
24	removed from Designated Barricaded Area or consumed inside vehicles while on public streets or		
25	alleys at the event.		

26	<u>Section 5</u> . This Resolution shall take effect and be in force after its approval by the
27	Governing Body.
