13	Section 2.	Having considered the request of the sponsor of the Second Saturday	
14	Summer Concert S	series for 2020 to allow the possession and consumption of alcoholic	
15	liquor, the governing body hereby approves the event to be held on July 11 and August 8,		
16	between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. the following morning provided the sponsor		
17	secures a tempora	ry permit from ABC and complies with all state laws and ordinances	
18	regulating alcoholic liquor.		
19	Section 3.	All or a portion of the following streets/alleys shall be closed to motor	
20	vehicle traffic during the dates and times identified in Section 2: SW 8 th Avenue from		
21	Jackson Street to Kansas Avenue. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719 and 41-2645, the sponsor		
22	shall ensure that the area in which alcoholic liquor is possessed or consumed is clearly		
23	marked by signs, a	posted map or other means ("Designated Barricaded Area").	
24	Section 4.	Event attendees may purchase, possess and consume alcoholic	

beverages within the Designated Barricaded Area. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719, no alcoholic

26	liquor may be removed from Designated Barricaded Area or consumed inside venicles		
27	while on public streets or alleys at the event.
