23	Procedures ("GB R	Rules") has established a set of rules and procedures to facilitate the	
24	business of the Go	verning Body; and	
25	WHEREAS,	the GB Rules require in-person, televised meetings in the Council	
26	Chambers during w	hich public comment is to be received; and	

27	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of Topeka residents, elected City official		
28	and employees of the City of Topeka are of critical importance and are endangered by the		
29	threat and spread of COVID-19; and		
30	WHEREAS, the Governing Body, in response to COVID-19, desires to protect the		
31	public health, safety and welfare by making temporary changes to the GB Rules that		
32	facilitate City business while protecting the public and those individuals who administer the		
33	business of the City.
