

**RESOLUTION NO. 9229**

A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Sylvia Ortiz supporting a fundraiser at Hummer Sports Park in conjunction with U.S.D. 501 to benefit the Topeka Housing Trust Fund

WHEREAS, the Governing Body, in its efforts to expand quality affordable housing for persons of low to moderate income, has established the Topeka Housing Trust Fund (“Fund”); and

WHEREAS, the Fund can be used only for the acquisition, rehabilitation and development of affordable housing and other supportive services; and

WHEREAS, monies placed in the Fund through donations will provide resources that can be used to address community, neighborhood, housing, and economic development needs that cannot be fully met with federal, state, or local funds; and

WHEREAS, while the Fund is administered by the City of Topeka, the Funds can be used only for Fund purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY THAT:

Section 1: In partnership with U.S.D. 501 and Superintendent Dr. Tiffany Anderson the Governing Body supports a fundraiser, which will be a showing of the movie “Coco” at the Hummer Sports Park soccer field on August 21, 2021. The movie will start at 8:00 p.m. and will be shown free of charge. The rain date is August 28, 2021.

Section 2: Goodwill donations will be accepted and used only as matching funds for Housing Trust Fund purposes.
