**RESOLUTION NO. 9270**

A RESOLUTION introduced by the members of the Public Infrastructure Committee comprised of Council Members Neil Dobler, Tony Emerson, and Mike Lesser recommending resumption of metered parking on certain downtown streets.

WHEREAS, since 2017, free parking has been allowed downtown on the 100 blocks off of Kansas Avenue (east and west) between 6<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> streets; and

WHEREAS, there has been a significant decline in parking revenue since March, 2020, and a 2022 budget forecasting a deficit of \$1.3 million; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Public Infrastructure Committee, after considering the matter on September 14, 2021, voted to recommend to the Governing Body: (1) removal of the parking hoods on meters located on the 100 blocks off of Kansas Avenue (east and west) between 6<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> streets; and (2) the imposition of two-hour metered parking.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that the City Manager is directed to facilitate the removal of the parking hoods on meters located on the 100 blocks off of Kansas Avenue (east and west) between 6<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> streets; and impose two-hour metered parking.

ADOPTED and APPROVED by the Governing Body on October 12, 2021.
