11	WHEREAS, the Mayor appointed a District Planning Committee ("Committee") to				
12	study and develop preliminary plans for the establishment and operation of the proposed				
13	NOTO BID; and				
14	WHEREAS, the Committee has submitted a report to the Governing Body: (1)				
15	advocating for the creation of the NOTO BID, (2) identifying its boundaries, (3) outlining				
16	the additional and extended services needed within the NOTO BID, (4) estimating the				
17	annual cost of providing those services during the next three years and (5) describing the				
18	proposed method of financing such costs ("NOTO BID Report") and				
19	WHEREAS, the Governing Body now desires to propose and consider the				
20	establishment of the NOTO BID and to take the necessary steps to complete the process				
21	as required by K.S.A. 12-1781 et seq.				
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE				
23	CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS that:				
24	1. The boundaries of the proposed NOTO BID encompass the following areas:				
25	Tier 1: North boundary: Gordon Street				
26	South boundary: Norris Street				
27	East boundary: Quincy Street				
28	West boundary: Jackson Street

- 30 Tier 2: North boundary: Morse Street
- 31 South boundary: Gordon Street
- 32 East boundary: Quincy Street
- 33 West boundary: Jackson Street

2. By way of general description, the services proposed to be provided include: (a) maintenance of public sidewalks and parks, trash removal, snow treatment/removal; (b) safety; security; (c) beautification that will enhance the visual appeal of the NOTO BID, including banners, decorations and public art; and (d) promotion of the NOTO BID through television, radio, print and social media.

39 3. Based on the NOTO BID Report, it is estimated that the services generally
40 described in Section 2 above will cost \$17,000 per year for the next three years.

4. Based on the NOTO BID Report, the NOTO BID will be financed by an 42 annual service fee identified in Exhibit A that will be imposed annually on the businesses 43 within the District. However, no annual service fee will be imposed on businesses that 44 had a physical presence within the proposed BID boundaries on or before January 1, 45 2008.

5. In the event an ordinance establishing the NOTO BID is enacted, the ordinance will address appointment of a NOTO BID advisory board. The NOTO BID Report recommends a five-member board appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of the City Council, whose members are representatives of businesses located in the BID.

6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1787, the governing body will hold a public hearing on the proposed establishment of the NOTO BID in the City Council Chambers, located at 214 S.E. 8<sup>th</sup> street, on March 15, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the order of business permits.
