16	a.m. the following day, provided the sponsor secures a temporary permit from ABC and		
17	complies with all state laws and ordinances regulating alcoholic liquor.		
18	Section 3.	All or a portion of the following streets/alleys shall be closed to motor	
19	vehicle traffic durin	g the dates and times identified in Section 2: Kansas Avenue between	
20	SW 8 th Avenue and	d SW 9 th Street. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719 and 41-1201, the sponsor	
21	shall ensure that the area in which alcoholic liquor is possessed or consumed is clearly		
22	marked by signs, a posted map or other means ("Designated Barricaded Area").		
23	Section 4.	Event attendees may purchase, possess and consume alcoholic	
24	beverages within th	ne Designated Barricaded Area. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719, no alcoholic	
25	liquor may be rem	oved from Designated Barricaded Area or consumed inside vehicles	

while on public streets or alleys at the event.
