17	WHEREAS, crimes of violence, as defined at K.A.R. 14-21-22, have occurred at
18	45 th Street, specifically four shootings in 2021 and 2022, the most recent on November 4,
19	2022 which resulted in a homicide; and
20	WHEREAS, between the establishment's opening for business in 2019 and
21	November 4, 2022, law enforcement has been dispatched numerous times for assaults,
22	fights and general disturbances resulting in a drain on public resources; and
23	WHEREAS, 45th Street is a threat to public health, safety and welfare.
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
25	CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:
26	1. The Governing Body requests of the Director that the City Manager be notified
27	of any application to renew the drinking establishment license of 45th Street – License No.

30	2. The Governing Body requests that the Director hold a hearing to revoke the
31	license based upon evidence that crimes of violence have occurred, the licensed premises
32	constitute an unreasonable drain on public resources to protect the safety of patrons, and
33	the licensed premises are a threat to the public's health, safety and welfare.
