

RESOLUTION NO. 9550

A RESOLUTION introduced by the Policy and Finance Committee comprised of Councilmembers Marcus Miller, Spencer Duncan and Michelle Hoferer, authorizing the use of \$59,589.19 from the Unassigned Reserve Fund for the replacement of faulty smoke and fire damper actuators at Hotel Topeka.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 9512 establishes a policy regarding Unassigned Reserve Fund expenditures that requires Governing Body authorization; and

WHEREAS, there are 36 sleeping rooms in Hotel Topeka with faulty fire and smoke damper actuators that need replaced; and

WHEREAS the Governing Body agrees with the need to replace the actuators.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that it authorizes \$59,589.19 from the Unassigned Reserve Fund to replace faulty smoke and fire damper actuators in Hotel Topeka. This project meets one or more of the conditions stated in Resolution No. 9512 for use of said funds.
