RESOLUTION NO. 9576

A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Dr. Robert M. Perez, authorizing initiation of eminent domain proceedings to acquire temporary easement for public infrastructure improvements in the Hi-Crest Neighborhood from SE 37th Street to SE 31st and from the Landon Nature Trail to SE Adams Street - Project No. 841097.01.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Topeka, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 26-201 that it is necessary and advisable in the public interest to condemn within the corporate limits of the City of Topeka certain private property interests for public infrastructure improvements in the Hi-Crest Neighborhood from SE 37th Street to SE 31st and from the Landon Nature Trail to Se Adams Street and any other public purposes as are authorized by law.

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 26-201, the Engineering Division is hereby authorized and directed to cause a survey to be made by some competent engineer of the private property which is necessary to be appropriated for the improvements, and such other public purposes as are authorized by law, and the City Engineer or designee, is authorized and directed to file the report of the survey, including a description of the private property and the interest to be acquired by condemnation, in the office of the City Clerk.

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective upon one publication in the official city newspaper.
